



ORGANISATIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

VIII National Conference Surveying Students' Scientific Groups

**University of Agriculture in Krakow
Krakow, 22. – 23. April, 2013.**

1. VIII National Conference Surveying Students' Scientific Groups is a form of academic conference, whose aim is to present and review results of research conducted by students in the student activities in scientific groups.
2. The organizer of VIII National Conference Surveying Students' Scientific Groups is Surveying Students' Scientific Group, which is acting at the University of Agricultural in Krakow and the National Geodetic Students Club.
3. The participant of Conference can be any student I, II and III degree studies of surveying, who is running in a scientific group, interested in scientific issues, which alone or in a group will prepare a paper using the scientific help by research worker/s at the university.
4. The paper should be a conclusion of the research / laboratory measurements, field measurements or project which are doing by the by the author (or authors).
5. The Conference aims to present the academic community the scientific achievements of members of different Surveying Students' Scientific Groups affiliated to the National Geodetic Students Club and invited guests. The aim is to identify and reward the most valuable paper.
6. The presented paper must be the copyrighted work of a participant. There is allowed to prepare collaborative work by several authors. If the work is done under a grant at the university implemented a participant of the Conference, should be given the topic number.
7. The submitted paper may not contain content from another publication (within the meaning of the Copyright Act).

8. The results presented by the participants of the conference cannot be part of the forthcoming licentiate thesis, engineering or Master's thesis.
9. In case the paper is a continuation of earlier work of author or authors, the corresponding information (refer to previous results and information on the extent of their use) should be included in the content of the paper and should be included in the text of the summary of the paper, which must be delivered to the Organizer, with a minimum of 10 days prior to the Competition.
10. The paper should be presented in the form of a multimedia presentation, understandable scientific language. Presentations will not exceed 10 minutes.
11. VIII National Conference Surveying Students' Scientific Groups consists of two competition panels of papers.
12. Established at the time of the Conference the Jury assessed: merit, formal qualities of novelty, self-working, the presentation by the author (s) presented papers, then chooses to reward in each panel 3 the best papers by awards and chooses to grant in each panel another 4 the best papers.
13. The Jury member of The VIII National Conference Surveying Students' Scientific Groups will be the research workers by The University of Agricultural in Krakow and invited guests, all with a minimum of a PhD.
14. Application for participation in the conference is tantamount to acceptance the organisational rules and regulations. The participation take responsibility for consequences of non-compliance or violation of the Rules.
15. Disputes and not included in the Regulations rules are decided by the Organizer.
